Martin and his wife spent 25 years in the Hot Springs Rehabilitation Center, where Martin was an instructor in various programs. Martin says, "In those years, we were blessed with a home, the children completing collage and this without debt!"

Martin and Barbara had visited Franklin many times to visit their son, Tim and join him in some activities. This gave them good knowledge about the county, along with their search for a good Assisted Living community close to Tim's home. After 57 years in Arkansas and working with M.A.D.D., they decided to make the move to The Fountains due to health care needs, therapy for both, disc failure in Martin's back and loss of the use of his legs.
